NOTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER CGCA MEETING

John Pulgini updated the CGCA membership on the Developer's new plans for 38R Minot. They have proposed building three 2,100 square foot townhouses to replace the existing two family house facing Minot Street on the corner of Ann Street.

State Rep Dan Cullinane shared updates on the Trolley and his work to call attention to the importance of preserving this transportation option for the neighbors.

Pat Fandel from Mayor Walsh's Office of Neighborhood Services shared information about the Adams St Library Community meeting and the new Blue Bike's station in Adams Village on Gallivan Blvd. He also mentioned the upcoming availability of Community Block mini-grants and neighborhood cleanups for beautification projects: <https://www.boston.gov/civic-engagement/love-your-block>

Roy Smith CGCA Treasurer shared the Association's efforts to improve the Adams Village Triangle green space in front of the Old Dorchester Post. The goal is to bring the local business, elected officials and community together to install plantings and provide an ongoing maintenance plan. With so many new businesses and visitors, this would be a great time to beautify the corner!

Dave Anderson CGCA President provided an update on the McDonald's expansion proposal. There was no news from the owner, but members at the meeting discussed the need to advocate for the driveway gates to be closed at night, the installation of security cameras, better trash pick-up by McDonald's in the area surrounding the restaurant and the closing of the exit onto Granite Ave. Dave also mentioned that the subcommittees from St Ann's/St Brendan's were working hard on planning events and encouraging greater Mass participation, increasing donations and seeking volunteer participation.
