Minutes from the December 2018 Meeting

- BPD Officer Sgt. Dunford gave a public safety update.
- A representative from the Boston Department of Inspectional Services provided an overview of the ordinance to ban disposable bags in the city starting on December 14, 2018.
- A proposal to grant variances to allow for the construction of a new three family house on a non-conforming lot on Granite Avenue adjacent to 114 Milton Street, in an area zoned for residential two family houses, was disapproved by a vote of the CGCA membership.
- A proposal to grant variances allowing for the construction of a multi-unit condominium complex at 18 Plain Street, a lot currently occupied by a single family house in an area zoned for residential single family houses, was disapproved by a vote of the CGCA membership.
