The City of Boston Scholarship Program is designed to support higher education, and is available to Boston residents interested in pursuing an undergraduate degree or continuing education in Massachusetts. Boston residents are encouraged to apply online. The deadline is Friday, April 12, 2019 at 5 p.m. To be eligible for the scholarship, you must be a Boston resident for at least two years as of January 1, 2019. The scholarship is for new or current college students AND continuing education students who plan to attend a post-secondary school in Massachusetts.
