Kim Foltz and Jen Rowe from Boston Transportation gave an update and information on the city's Blue Bikes program. They are hoping to place new Blue Bike stations along the Neponset River Rail Trail, the Lower Mills Library, and near the Adams Branch Library once it is reopened following the upcoming construction.

Vote on 80-82 Minot street took place. Vote was 9-9, tied in opposition vs support. Steve Bickerton Jr. explained that the Association will send a letter to ZBA indicating that the association is neutral on the proposed project.
