Minutes from the May 2019 Meeting

Molinari Pizzeria owner Jeff Cincotta shared will be to applying to expand his current liquor license from beer and wine to include cordials. The restaurant is taking over the storefront next door and going from 12 tables to 16-18 and seating from 27 to about 48. The CGCA will take a vote once he submits a written application for the liquor license.

Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Services Coordinator Pat Fandel spoke about Mayor Walsh's \$2.78 Billion 2020-2024 Capital Plan. \$19 million is included for the new Adams Street Library that area residents have participated in the design process. Other Capital Projects include Garvey Park renovations & the Kenny School Fresh Foods for Students Project.

Adams's Village Triangle Plaza - Lucy's American Tavern has spearheaded the landscaping, labor & irrigation installation.
